DECISION

THIS MATTER COMING ON to be heard pursuant to the Order of the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois in case number 15 CH 16065 entered September 28, 2016, remanding this matter to the Merit Board "solely for reconsideration and reversal of Mr. Burruss' termination with instructions to impose a lesser penalty" the Cook County Sheriff's Merit Board finds as follows:

The Cook County Sheriff's Merit Board adopts the factual findings set forth in its order of October 15, 2015, and in compliance with the Order of the Circuit Court of Cook County on remand, imposes as the maximum penalty allowed by statute short of termination, a 180 day suspension.

Order: Wherefore, based on the foregoing, it is hereby ordered that the Respondent William Burruss be suspended for 180 days from employment effective May 8, 2012.
