Not Accepted:

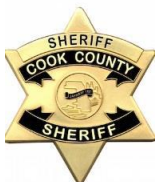
Car batteries, Appliances, Tubed Computer Monitors (CRT), and Toner cartridges

PRESCRIPTION REQUIREMENTS:

PRESCRIPTION DRUGS OR NON-PRESCRIBED PHARMACEUTICALS CAN BE LEFT IN THEIR CONTAINERS.

NO HYPODERMIC NEEDLES OR LIQUID MEDICINES

Bring documents that contain personal information to be safely shredded, such as bank statements, medical records, old tax returns, pay stubs, bills, receipts, and other personal documents.
